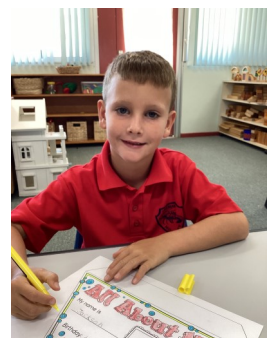

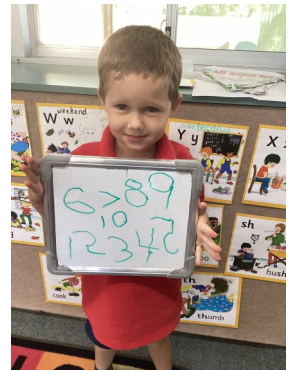

Junior Room

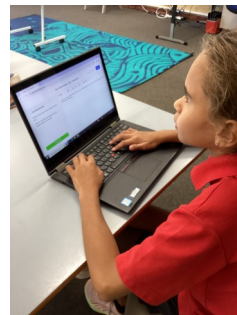
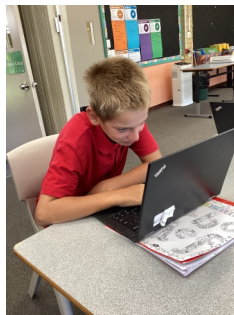
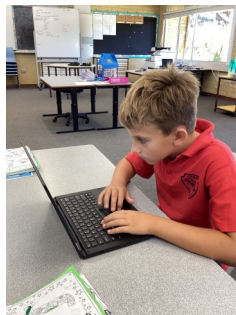
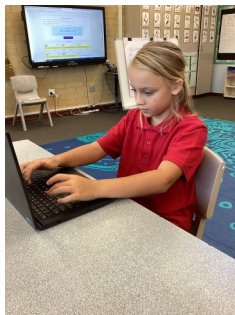


The Junior room have been busy learning their numbers and the kindy's have also been busy practicing their handwriting.

Leeman Primary School uses the **messageyou™ student absences messaging system**. The system will send a text message (SMS) to parent/guardian phones when your child is absent from school and a follow up message 8 days later if you haven't replied with an absence reason.

SMS may also be used to provide information to parents such as school community notices and emergency / unplanned events such as school closures.
