CO2 Car Race


The students have been working with Mr Mori to design and build their CO2 Dragsters. The Green Head Men's Shed cut out the students designs ready for them to paint.



With a focus on personalised learning, SIDE ensures that each student receives the support they need to succeed, whether through one-on-one teacher interactions or group discussions.


















The Book Fair is coming to Leeman Primary School!
